Three topics in GAS: Keep Sabbath Holy; Attend Church; Sacrament

What is the Sabbath?

Day of "Rest"

Numbered Days vs. days of the gods of the visible heavens

Part of the Cosmic order of creation

Gen 2:3: And God **blessed** the **seventh day**, and **sanctified** (*qaddeš*) it: because that in it he had **rested** from all his work which God created and made."

Imitation of God by keeping Sabbath

Keep the Sabbath Day Holy = "Sanctify the Day of Rest"

Exodus 20:8, "Remember $(z\bar{a}k\hat{o}r)$ the Sabbath day, to keep it holy $(qadde\check{s})$."

Exodus 31:14 = death for violating the Sabbath

Deuteronomy 5:12, "**Observe** ($\delta \bar{a}m\hat{o}r = guard$) the Sabbath day, to **keep it holy** ($qadde\delta$), as the LORD your God commanded you."

Nehemiah 13:22, "Then I commanded the **Levites** that they should **purify** themselves and come and **guard the gates** [of the temple], to **keep** (*qaddeš*) **the Sabbath day holy**."

Negative vs. Positive?: what not to do vs. what to do

desecrating the Sabbath day in the pursuit of worldly pleasures, they will lose their faith; and the Spirit of our Heavenly Father will withdraw from them (GAS 171)

NT Sabbath

Sabbath = 7th day of the Week

Sunday = 1st Day/8th Day = Lord's [Jesus' Day] because of resurrection

Jewish Christians in Synagogue on Saturday, in Christian meetings on Sunday

Sacrament

What is the Sacrament?

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Sacrament = that which is holy (sacer)

= Sacrifice = act of making holy

Sanctify the Sabbath = sacralize the Sabbath

Sacrament = what makes the Sabbath Day holy

eucharist = thanksgiving εὐχαριστήσας = give thanks, 1 Cor. 11:23

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Context

human food-sharing instinct
sharing food as kinship, guest
Sacrament = shared meal with God

Sacrament as token of the new covenant

All ancient covenants need a sacrifice (berît) and a sign ('ôt)

New Testament = kainēs diathēkē = New Covenant

Lk. 22:20, 1 Cor. 11:25

Heb. 8:8 translated as "new covenant"

- Jer. 31:31-34 (berît hadāšāh = kainēv diathēkēv)
- **Heb. 9:15** "And for this cause he is the mediator of the **new testament**, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance."

Proto-Sacrament in the OT

Melchizedek (Gen. 14:18-20; •Gen. 14:18)
Abraham and the three angelic guests (Gen. 18)
Eating with God on Sinai (•Ex. 24:9-11)

Bread and Wine offerings

Meat offerings vs. Bread and wine offerings at the Temple

- = drink offering (nesek) = Num. 15; Num. 28-29
- = bread/grain ($minh\bar{a}h$)

Special Sabbath sacrifices at temple = Sabbath was a temple ritual

•Ex. 20:8-11 = only temple ritual required in ten commandments based on created order of Gen.

Num 28:9-10 = double daily/tamîd (*tamîd*) sacrifice + Ezek. 46:4-5

And on the sabbath day two lambs of the first year without spot, and two tenth deals of flour for a **meat (grain/bread vs. flesh) offering**, mingled with oil, and the **drink offering** thereof: 10 This is the **burnt offering** of every sabbath, beside the continual burnt offering, and his **drink offering**.

1 Chr. 9:32 = 12 pieces of bread set out on Sabbath on the table

The Last Supper

= Passover sacrifice, = temple ritual eaten by people who bring the lamb Passover Sacrifice as a temple pilgrimage & sacrifice

vs. Jewish Passover today

Matthew 26:26–28 +Mark 14:22–24

- •1 Corinthians 11:23-26
- •Luke 22:19–20v
- 3 Nephi 18:7, Christ implements Sacrament among Nephites

7 And this shall ye do in **remembrance** of my body, which I have shown unto you. And it shall be a **testimony** unto the Father that ye do always **remember** me. And if ye do always **remember** me ye shall have my Spirit to be with you.

DC 20:75-79 = Moroni 4-5

Bread = O God, the Eternal Father, we ask thee in the name of thy Son, Jesus Christ, to **bless** and **sanctify** this bread to the souls of all those who partake of it; that they may eat in **remembrance** of the body of thy Son, and **witness** unto thee, O God, the Eternal Father, <u>that they are willing to take upon them the name of thy Son</u>, and always **remember** him, <u>and keep his commandments</u> which he hath given them, that they may **always have his Spirit to be with them**. Amen.

Wine = O God, the Eternal Father, we ask thee, in the name of thy Son, Jesus Christ, to **bless** and **sanctify** this wine to the souls of all those who drink of it, that they may do it in **remembrance** of the blood of thy Son, which was shed for them; that they may **witness** unto thee, O God, the Eternal Father, that they do always **remember** him, that they may have his Spirit to be with them. Amen.
