Dexter Van Zile

is a Christian Media Analyst for CAMERA. His work focuses on the failure of Christian leaders to address human rights abuses in Muslim-majority countries in the Middle East. He has also played a major role in exposing the errors in the Palestinian Christian narrative. His book, Submitted Under Protest: Essays Written in Defense of Western Freedom. documents his work.

Dr. Tricia Miller

is a Christian Media Analyst for CAMERA. She monitors Christian organizations and media in relation to the Arab-Israeli conflict and focuses specifically on the effects of Christian anti-Zionism on support for Israel in the Evangelical world. Her book, *Jews and Anti-Judaism in Esther and the Church*, addresses the relationship of the Book of Esther to current Christian anti-Judaism and anti-Zionism.

Dr. Brad Young

is professor of Biblical Literature in the School of Theology and Ministry at Oral Roberts University in Tulsa, OK. He earned his PhD from Hebrew University, Jerusalem with a specialization in New Testament Studies and the Jewish beginnings of Christianity. His passion is to study and teach the Jesus presented in the Synoptic Gospels in the context of ancient Judaism. Brad's work enables students and readers to understand the Jewish setting of the beginnings of Christian faith.

Rev. Dr. Gerald McDermott

is an Anglican priest and serves as the Anglican Chair of Divinity at Samford University's Beeson Divinity School in Birmingham AL. A prolific author, he has written, co-written, or edited eighteen books and scores of articles, many of which address the subject of Christian Zionism. Most recently, Gerald has been writing and speaking on the meaning of Israel.

is the Founder and Executive Director of Eagles' Wings Ministries. He has ministered in 30 nations around the world and maintains a significant burden for the Eastern United States and for Israel. A powerful communicator, Robert is in international demand as a speaker and musician.
